### PURPOSE

To recognize the best research at the Psi Chi Student Poster Session



### AWARD DESCRIPTION

Students are invited to submit paper and poster proposals for presentation during the Psi Chi program, held during the Annual Convention of the Association for Psychological Science (APS). Psi Chi has reserved a special portion of the Psi Chi program for this Psi Chi Student Poster Session.



### ELIGIBILITY

1. The first author of each proposal must be a student Psi Chi member.
2. Each proposal must include an APS member as a sponsor.
3. Submitters can be first author on only one poster proposal.
4. Proposals submitted for possible presentation at other professional meetings are not acceptable for the APS Convention. If you submit a proposal for the regular APS poster session, do not submit the same proposal for the Psi Chi poster session.



### STYLE / STANDARDS

1. Submissions must be an electronic document written in English conforming strictly to the instructions in the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA)*.
2. The text of the submission should be in 12-point font (double-spaced).
3. Poor spelling and grammar will penalize otherwise sound submissions. Faculty sponsors are encouraged to review submissions prior to entry.
4. All proposals must be masked, with any identifying information only on the proposal cover sheet. Your Psi Chi member ID number will serve as a unique identifier for your submission.
5. Only research that has been completed by the time of proposal submission will be considered for review.



### SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

1. Submit online [www.psichi.org](http://www.psichi.org) under the AWARDS/GRANTS section. The link for submission is available at least one month prior to the submission deadline.
2. Submissions are accepted until midnight local time on December 1. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. Submission form (next page).
4. Upload a 50-word abstract of the research.
5. Upload a 400 to 500-word summary of the research.
6. The first author must register for the convention and pay the registration fee.
