Purpose

The National Leadership Conference (NLC) will provide workshops, keynote speakers, and interactive sessions that help Psi Chi chapter presidents develop skills to be effective leaders of their chapter and in the profession and that help Psi Chi faculty advisors enhance their leadership skills and expand their impact on psychology education.

Program

- The program includes plenary sessions with presentations from two internationally recognized leaders in psychology, concurrent workshop sessions on topics of interest to chapter presidents and faculty advisors, small discussion groups that provide opportunities for participants to share ideas and apply information from the conference sessions, and informal participant idea exchanges.
- The conference package includes the reception on Friday evening and breakfast, lunch, and two refreshment breaks on Saturday.
- Participants will receive a conference proceedings binder that will include summaries from each presentation, articles from *Eye on Psi Chi* related to leadership and conference presentations, suggested readings related to each session, biographical sketches of presenters, and Psi Chi resource materials.

Psi Chi Funding: For the first 60 eligible chapter presidents, presidents-elect, or faculty advisors who register for the conference, Psi Chi will pay for the hotel room and room tax (double occupancy), reimburse the registrant for travel up to \$500 (registrant must provide a receipt for airfare, train fare, or bus fare, or a record of mileage), and provide two MARTA rapid-transit tickets for transportation between the airport and the Dunwoody MARTA Station. The hotel provides free shuttle service between the Dunwoody Station and the hotel. Psi Chi will notify registrants about funding no later than October 16, 2006.

To be eligible for Psi Chi funding, participants must be from chapters beyond a 100-mile radius of Atlanta and must attend the entire conference. Psi Chi funding is limited to one president or president-elect and one faculty advisor per chapter.

Conference participants who are funded by Psi Chi are responsible for arranging their own travel to the conference; paying the conference registration fee; and paying for all incidental charges to their hotel rooms,

travel expenses that exceed \$500, meals that are not included in the NLC, and all other expenses associated with their attendance at the NLC.

Nonfunded Participants: Chapter presidents or presidents-elect and advisors who live within a 100-mile radius of Atlanta, GA and other chapter presidents or presidents-elect and advisors who are not funded by Psi Chi are welcome to attend the conference but must pay the registration fee and all other expenses associated with attending the conference. Space is limited for nonfunded participants so registrants are encouraged to send their registration early. Also, please note that chapters are limited to no more than two participants (one chapter president or president elect and one faculty advisor), whether the participants receive funding from Psi Chi or pay their own way. Psi Chi will provide additional information to non-funded registrants no later than October 16, 2006.

Hotel Reservations: Psi Chi will make hotel reservations for all participants, whether they receive Psi Chi funding or pay their own way, at the Crowne Plaza Atlanta Perimeter NW hotel. Participants should not make their own reservations at the hotel.

Cancellation Policy: The deadline for cancellations with a full refund of the registration fee is November 1, 2006 for all participants, whether funded by Psi Chi or not. Registration fees will not be refunded for cancellations after this date. Cancellations must be in writing and should include the address to which the refund should be sent.

Directions to the Crowne Plaza

Location: The Crowne Plaza Atlanta Perimeter NW Hotel is located on 6345 Powers Ferry Road off I-285 at Exit 22, which is one exit east of the junction of I-75 and I-285. The hotel is approximately 21 miles from the Atlanta Hartsfield Jackson International Airport.

MARTA: Participants funded by Psi Chi will receive two MARTA tickets. The MARTA subway runs from the airport to Dunwoody Station (approximately 6 miles from the hotel). The hotel provides free shuttle service between this station and the hotel. Pickup times at the Dunwoody Station are at 9:30 AM, 12:30 PM, 2:30 PM, and 7:30 PM. Hotel guests must call the hotel to inform the driver they are waiting at the station at a particular pick-up time. The hotel phone number is 770-955-1700.

Taxi: Taxi fare from the Dunwoody Station to the hotel is approximately \$12.00. Taxi fare from the airport is approximately \$45.00.

FUNDING

For the first 60 eligible registrants, Psi Chi will pay for the hotel room (double occupancy) for January 5 and 6, up to \$500 in travel expenses (for airfare, train fare, bus fare, or mileage), and two MARTA rapid transit tickets for travel between the airport and hotel. Funded participants must pay the registration fee and all other expenses associated with attending the conference. To be eligible for funding, participants must be from chapters beyond a 100-mile radius of Atlanta and must attend the entire conference. Psi Chi funding is limited to one president or president-elect and one faculty advisor per chapter. Registrants will be notified about Psi Chi funding no later than **October 16, 2006**.

Chapter presidents/presidents-elect and advisors who live within a 100-mile radius of Atlanta, GA and other chapter presidents/presidents-elect and advisors who are not funded by Psi Chi are welcome to attend the conference but must pay the registration fee as well as pay for their own hotel room (if needed), travel, meals not provided at the conference, and all other expenses associated with attending the conference. No more than one advisor and one president from a school may register for the conference. Space is limited for non-funded participants so registrants are encouraged to send their registration early. Psi Chi will provide additional information to non-funded registrants no later than **October 16, 2006**.

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TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Participants must arrange their own travel to the conference. All participants should arrive at the hotel on Friday, January 5 in time to pick up conference materials between 3:00 PM - 6:00 PM and depart on Sunday, January 7. **Participants funded by Psi Chi** will receive two MARTA rapid transit tickets for travel between the airport and the Dunwoody MARTA station. The hotel provides a free shuttle service between this station and the hotel. In order to be reimbursed for up to \$500 for travel expenses, funded participants must attend the entire conference and provide a receipt for air, train, or bus fare or a record of mileage for roundtrip travel between their home or school and the conference hotel.

HOUSING ARRANGEMENTS

Psi Chi will make room reservations at the Crowne Plaza Atlanta Perimeter NW hotel for NLC participants. Participants should not make their own reservations with this hotel. All rooms have two double beds. **For participants funded by Psi Chi**, Psi Chi will pay for double occupancy only. If participants funded by Psi Chi request single occupancy rooms, they must pay half of the room rate and taxes. Chapter presidents will share a room with another chapter president of the same sex; advisors will share a room with another chapter advisor of the same sex.
