  - 2 Served one year as Past-President on the National Council before the Psi Chi Constitution and Bylaws were changed in 1986 instituting the current offices of President-Elect and Past-President.
  - 3 From 1986–1998, the past-president of Psi Chi also served as historian.
  - 4 This region was recombined with the Eastern Region because NEPA did not (at that time) allow Psi Chi to sponsor programs at its conventions.
