# Psi Chi Distinguished Member Nomination Form

## A. THE AWARD

1. The purpose of awarding the designation of Psi Chi Distinguished Member is to recognize those individuals making significant contributions both to psychology and Psi Chi.
2. The recipient will be awarded a plaque by Psi Chi. An article detailing the accomplishments of the new Distinguished Member will be included in the Fall issue of *Eye on Psi Chi*, the national magazine of Psi Chi.

## B. CRITERIA

1. Distinguished members shall have national or international reputations because of clear and extensive contributions made to psychology and to Psi Chi in the areas of research, service, and/or teaching.
2. Distinguished members must have a minimum of 10 years service in the area of psychology and/or Psi Chi.
3. Psi Chi membership is not part of the criteria in being considered for Psi Chi Distinguished Member; however, Distinguished Members shall have all the rights and privileges of active membership. They pay no dues or fees of any kind.

## C. NOMINATION PROCEDURES

1. Candidates may be nominated by a chapter or by a member of the National Council by submitting the name and qualifications to the National Council. Only the National Council may elect distinguished members.
2. Nominations are welcome throughout the calendar year and will be considered at the National Council meeting following their submissions. Therefore, there is no set deadline for receipt of nominations.
3. Nominations may receive external review by psychologists who are not currently serving on the Psi Chi National Council.

## D. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

### Contents of Submission

- a. The submission form on this page (or a cover sheet containing precisely the same information.)
- b. A statement describing the nominee's contributions to psychology (include summary of research, list of publications, overview of teaching career, other contributions in the area of undergraduate and/or graduate education, grants, awards, etc.).
- c. A statement describing the nominee's contributions to Psi

Chi.

- d. A one-page summary of why the nominee believes this individual is worthy of the Distinguished Member honor. This one-page summary may be published (in part or total) in *Eye on Psi Chi*.
