



Award Description

The purpose of the Psi Chi Model Chapter Awards is to recognize and reward annually those chapters that consistently maintain outstanding records of membership inductions, chapter correspondence, service projects, and other criteria associated with being an outstanding chapter.

Winning chapters will receive a \$100 award and a certificate noting their achievement as a model chapter, based upon the award committee's recommendation. A list of all winning chapters will be featured in *Eye on Psi Chi*.

Eligibility

All Psi Chi chapters are eligible for this award. In order to be a Model Chapter Award winner, the chapter must meet the five criteria listed below.

1. Chapter submitted Annual/Financial Reports by June 30. Reports should document:
 - a. chapter participation in at least one service project,
 - b. chapter participation in regional convention or undergraduate research conference, and
 - c. chapter participation in Psi Chi awards program.
2. Chapter submitted Chapter Activities/Chapter Officer Reports for *Eye on Psi Chi* by February 15th of the current fiscal year.
3. Chapter voted in Society elections.
4. Chapter conducted at least one induction during the year, with preference for one per semester.
5. Chapter has no outstanding debts to Central Office.

Submission Procedures

Chapters do not need to submit an application form for the Model Chapter designation. The Psi Chi Central Office will verify through its database those chapters that have met the award criteria. All chapters submitting evidence of meeting the criteria shown above will be designated as a winner. Winning chapters will be eligible to win in subsequent years.
