Award Description

The award will be given for the best overall research. For purposes of this award, "research" broadly includes all forms of empirical psychology, such as experiments, correlational studies, historical studies, case histories, and evaluation studies.

This award honors Edwin Broomell Newman, whose activities beginning in 1927 led him to be a cofounder of Psi Chi and to nurture its growth during its formative years. This award is presented during the prestigious American Psychological Foundation/American Psychological Association (APF/APA) Awards ceremony at the APA/Psi Chi Society Annual Convention in August.

The winner receives the following:

1. travel expenses to attend the APA/Psi Chi Society Annual Convention to receive the award,
2. a three-year subscription to an APA journal of the winner's choice, and
3. two engraved plaques, one for the winner and one for the winner's psychology department as a permanent honor to the winner.

Eligibility

The submitter of a research paper:

1. Need not be a Psi Chi member.
2. Must be a graduate student at the time the research was carried out and the paper submitted for presentation.
3. Must be the primary and first author.
4. Must have published and/or presented the paper at a national, regional, or state psychology convention between January 1 and December 31 of the previous calendar year.
5. Winner is not eligible to receive the Newman Award and the Psi Chi/APS Albert Bandura Graduate Research Award in the same year.

Style/Standards

1. An electronic document which conforms strictly to the instructions in APA's *Publication Manual*. Published reprints will not be accepted.
2. The text of the paper is limited to a maximum of 12 pages in 12-point font (double-spaced). In addition to the 12 pages of text, the paper should include a title page, a 120-word abstract, references, and any tables, figures, or notes that are necessary.
3. All papers receive masked review. The manuscript should include a separate title page with authors' names and affiliations, and these should not appear anywhere else on the manuscript. Footnotes that identify the authors should be on a separate page. **Authors should ensure that the manuscript itself contains no clue to their identity.**

Submission Procedures

1. Submit online at www.psichi.org under the AWARDS/GRANTS section. The link for submissions is available at least one month prior to the submission deadline.
2. Submissions are accepted online until midnight local time on February 1. Late entries cannot be accepted.
3. Submit researcher information contained on the submission form to the right.
4. Submit one copy of the research paper.

Winner Responsibilities

The winner will provide the Psi Chi Central Office with the following for publication in *Eye on Psi Chi*.

- A 120-word APA-style abstract
- A 150-word biography (third person)
- A digital photo (600KB file size)

These items need to be emailed to awards@psichi.org by March 15 of the winning year.

All proposals must be written in English.
