Psi Chi/Website Awards

Award Description

The purposes of the Psi Chi Website Awards program are to recognize and reward annually those chapter websites that (a) create an innovative, aesthetic, and useful site, and (b) best advance or support Psi Chi's purpose, "to encourage, stimulate, and maintain excellence in scholarship of the individual members in all fields, particularly in psychology, and to advance the science of psychology."

Three cash awards of \$200 each will be presented to the winning chapters. Summaries of the award winners' websites will be featured in *Eye on Psi Chi* and on the Psi Chi website at www.psichi.org.

Eligibility

All Psi Chi chapters are eligible to submit their website for consideration. First consideration will be given to chapters that have not won a website award within the past three years. Submissions will be assessed on the following criteria:

1. the creativity, layout, and usability of design,
2. how well the site achieves Psi Chi's purpose statement, and
3. a short one-page summary statement that describes the site.

Style/Standards

1. An electronic document which conforms strictly to the instructions in the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (APA).

2. The text of the paper is limited to one page in 12-point font (double-spaced).

Submission Procedures

1. Submit the application online at www.psichi.org under the AWARDS/GRANTS section. The link is available at least one month prior to the submission deadline.
2. Submissions are accepted online until midnight local time on February 1. Late submissions cannot be accepted.
3. Online submission should include:
 - a. **One Submission Form.** Complete the submission form online (see right side of this sheet for an example of the information that will be requested).
 - b. **One copy of Website Summary Statement.** The summary statement should include the information listed below.
 - i. **Purpose of Site.** Describe why you/your chapter created this website, and what you/your chapter hopes to convey with this website.
 - ii. **Uniqueness of Site.** Describe what makes your site stand out from other sites (e.g., layout, content, aesthetics, usability, innovation, creativity).
 - iii. **Philosophy of Site.** Describe the philosophy of your site and how the site content advances or supports the purposes or mission of Psi Chi.

All proposals must be written in English.
